plate linen glass ... (?) and other *Effects* whatsoever and appoint her my holt

and sole Executrix being for her own use and benefit and also all money or

legacies I may be possessed of at the time of my death also all rents and money

arising from my Benefit Society and Burial Society and also all property I may

be possessed of at the time of my death *Edward Lovelock*

Dated this 14 day of Jany 1837

Proved at London 7th September 1839 before the worshipful *Frederick Thomas*

Patt Doctor of Laws and Surrogate by the oath of *Jane Lovelock* widow and relict

And the sole executrix to whom admon was granted having been first sworn to admr.
