

This is the last Will and Testament of me

Elizabeth Lovelock of Inkpen in the County of Berks made this twelfth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighteen as follows that is to say I give and bequeath to my two Sisters in law Mary Knowles and Harriet Knowles of Inkpen aforesaid all my money securities for money plate linen wearing apparel goods chattels and property of any kind whatsoever of which I may be possessed at the time of my decease and I do hereby publish and declare this to be my last Will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year first above written Elizabeth Lovelock Signed sealed and delivered by the above named Elizabeth Lovelock in the presence of us who in her presence and at her request and in the presence of each other have signed our names as witness Joseph Elloway Elizabeth Stratton

On the 9th October 1833 Administration with the Will annexed of the Goods Chattels and Credits of Elizabeth Lovelock formerly of Inkpen but late of Welford in the County of Berks Spinster deceased was granted to Mary Knowles Spinster the natural and lawful Sister by the half blood out of the Universal Legatees named in the said Will having been first Sworn duly to Administer as Executor being so named in the said will
